

‘What Do You See in the Old House?’

Materials:

- Flashcards/pictures from the unit ‘The Old House’
- Sentence frames on the board: ‘I see a _____ in the old house.’

Steps:

1. Teacher Announces the Topic and Time

- Topic: ‘Things in the Old House’
- Time: 3 minutes

2. Think Time

- Pupils are given flashcards/pictures from the unit ‘The Old House’.
- Give pupils 30 seconds to think about what they saw in the old house.

3. In Pairs – Rally Robin Sharing

- Partner A says a sentence using the frame: 'I see a _ in the old house.'
- Partner B responds with a different item from the story using the same frame.
- They take turns (rally style) until the time is up or they run out of ideas.

4. Wrap-Up

- A few pairs share their favourite or funniest responses with the class.

Example sentences from pupils:

- 'I see a bat in the old house.'
- 'I see a spider in the old house.'
- 'I see a candle in the old house.'
- 'I see a curtain in the old house.'
