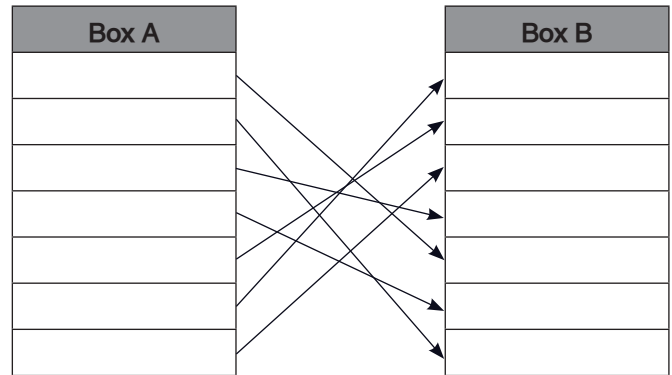
Dear Danial,
